Shu-Ha-Ri is a way of thinking about how you learn a technique. The name comes from Japanese martial arts (particularly Aikido), and Alistair Cockburn introduced it as a way of thinking about learning techniques and methodologies for software development.. The idea is that a person passes through three stages of gaining knowledge:

If Agile were anti-documentation, why is there a manifesto? The "Agile Manifesto" was put together by seventeen software developers in 2001 - among them, Ward Cunningham, Jim Highsmith, Alistair Cockburn, and Bob Martin - and officially introduced the Agile development methodology as an alternative to the conventional documentation-driven, heavyweight software development process.
