Macroglossum trochilus, the African hummingbird hawk-moth, is a moth of the family Sphingidae. The species was first described by Jacob Hübner in 1823. It is very common in most habitats throughout southern and eastern Africa and in the Comoro Islands.. Adults are frequently seen at flowers in full sunshine.

Normal central heating should be adequate unless the species requires extra warmth (North African species). Simply lay out the pupae on damp peat to help them with a foothold during emergence. Some breeders slightly bury the abdomen end of the pupae to give more leverage for the emerging moth or lay moss on top of the pupae for added securing.
