#### Note: Quantitative Gram Stain Interpretation Criteria Used ...

Personnel performing moderate complexity testing, both laboratory and non-laboratory (e.g. nurses, respiratory therapists, radiologic technologists and medical assistants), must, at a MINIMUM, have earned a high school diploma or equivalent AND have records of training appropriate for the testing performed prior to analyzing patient specimens.
