If you are certain that the car is in neutral, you can remove your foot from the clutch. Ensure that the parking or emergency brake is not in use.

Driving manual or stick-shift will be somewhat difficult at first, but within a week or two of following this guide and practicing, it will become second nature. Driving an Automatic Transmission The silver pad on the left of this automatic transmission car is where you can rest your left foot.

## **Easiest Way to Learn to Drive a Manual Transmission or ...**

Depress the clutch pedal until it disengages and guide the gearstick straight down from first gear into the bottom-left position (which is second gear in most configurations). Some cars have a "Shift Light" or indications on the tachometer that will tell you when you need to shift, so you don't rev the engine too fast.

Push the ignition button or turn the key to start the truck. With the stick shift in neutral and both pedals still depressed, start your truck. For a traditional ignition, simply turn the key clockwise in the ignition. Newer trucks may require you to press a button instead. Push the stick shift into first gear.

Also known as a stick shift or a standard transmission, the manual requires the driver to literally change the gears. The "stick" is usually mounted on the center console, and it is directly connected to the transmission. In order for the driver to be able to change the transmission gears, he or she must release the clutch pedal.

A manual transmission requires the driver to operate the gear stick and clutch in order to change gears (unlike an automatic transmission or semi-automatic transmission, where one (typically the clutch) or both of these functions are automated). Most manual transmissions for cars allow the driver to select any gear ratio at any time, for example shifting from 2nd to 4th gear, or 5th to 3rd gear.
