The Hebrew word for almond, "shakeid," also means "watchful," so symbolically the almond represents God's watchfulness over his people. The almond tree is mentioned a number of times in the Old Testament, and is a source of one of Judaism's most important symbols: the menorah.

The almond tree is one of the first to awaken to the light of spring, to bud and flower. It is a sign for those who are watching. In fact, its name in Hebrew, shakeid, means to wake or watch. In Genesis we see Jacob using them to help produce a striped flock.

The almond fruit is 3.5–6 cm (1 3/8 – 2 3/8 in) long.In botanical terms, it is not a nut but a drupe.The outer covering or exocarp, fleshy in other members of Prunus such as the plum and cherry, is instead a thick, leathery, grey-green coat (with a downy exterior), called the hull. Inside the hull is a reticulated, hard, woody shell (like the outside of a peach pit) called the endocarp.
